Introduction

In the video "*The myth of the gay agenda*" TED reveals about his personal life experiences as a married man, father, and also a gay. In his quest about what gay community wants from the constitution, he gives insight into the plight of African-American civil rights arguing that it did not pursue the usual process of the popular vote. TED claims that the courts and Congress pioneered the process to civil rights, which eventually was moved by the

popular opinion. Granderson states that it is legal in 29 states to fire someone based on their sexual orientations, gay (TED, 2012).
